Master Instructor Alain Saily is respected internationally as one of the greatest Jujutsu instructors of our time. He is the founder of GoShinDo (Way of Self Protection) and is a founding member of the World Kobudo Federation.

Kyoshi Saily started Judo with his father at the age of 5 and was a serious student of many styles of martial arts. By his late teens he was competing at an international level in Judo, free style and Greco-Roman wrestling, Sambo and full-contact Jujutsu. After many years of professional level study of many martial arts, Kyoshi Saily founded the system of Goshindo in 1978, deriving it from his intense studies of Hakko Ryu Jujusu & Daito Ryu Aiki JuJutsu (the forerunners of modern Aikido and other Jujutsu styles). Currently, Kyoshi Alain Saily lives in the north of France in Carignan on the Belgium Border. He regularly teaches throughout Europe, Russia, Africa, the near east and North America. He is doing a teaching tour in Canada in January 2012 and we are fortunate to have him as a guest instructor for one evening.
